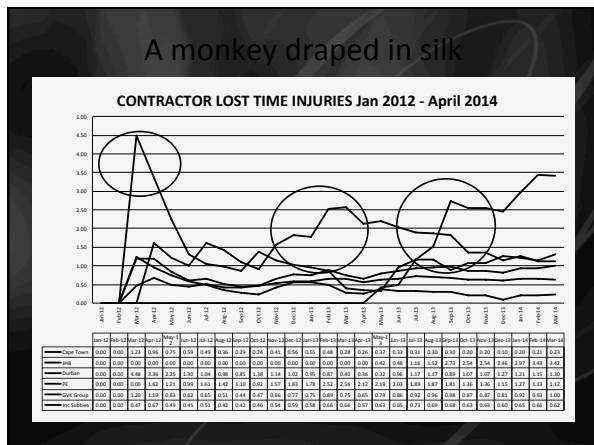

The monkey on our backs
